

Fast Facts

	Pneumonia	Acute Bronchitis
<i>Symptoms</i>	Coughing, chest pain when breathing/coughing, fatigue, fever, sweating, chills, shortness of breath, phlegm (usually clear) and nausea/vomiting/diarrhea	Coughing, shortness of breath, slight fever, chills, fatigue, chest discomfort, and mucus (which can be discolored)
<i>When to go to the Doctor</i>	Difficulty breathing, chest pain, persistent fever > 102°F, constant cough (especially if it contains pus)	Fever > 100.4°F with a cough that has lasted more than 3 weeks, prevents you from sleeping, produces discolored mucus or blood, and is associated with wheezing or shortness of breath
<i>Treatment</i>	-Antibiotics (Pneumonia and sometimes Acute Bronchitis) -Cough Medicine -Fever Reducer/Pain Reliever -Humidifier -Rest -Stay Hydrated	
<i>Prevention</i>	-Wash your hands -Get vaccinated (flu and pneumonia shots) -Don't smoke	

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
