When to go to the doctor for Gastroenteritis

<i>Adults</i>	<i>Children</i>
<ul style="list-style-type: none">-No liquids down for 24 hours-Vomiting > 2 days-Vomiting blood-Blood in your stool-Fever > 104°F-Dehydration (excessive thirst, dry mouth, deep yellow or no urine, severe weakness, dizziness, lightheadedness)	<ul style="list-style-type: none">-Fever > 102°F-Lethargic or very irritable-Severe or bloody diarrhea-Dehydrated (watch fluid intake and urine output for any changes)-Vomiting that lasts several hours-No wet diapers in 6 hours-Sunken soft spot (fontanel) on top of head-Cries with no tears-Unusual sleepy/drowsiness/unresponsiveness

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
