### Signs of a Stroke

	<i>Symptom</i>	<i>What is Going On</i>	<i>What to Do</i>
<i>F</i>	Face Drooping	Does one side of the face droop or feels numb to the patient?	Ask the person to smile. Does it look uneven?
<i>A</i>	Arm Weakness	Is one arm weak or numb?	Ask the person to raise both arms. Does one arm drift downward?
<i>S</i>	Speech Difficulty	Is the person's speech slurred? Are they are hard to understand? Can they not speak at all?	Ask the person to repeat a simple sentence, like "The sky is blue." Do they repeat it correctly and clearly?
<i>T</i>	Time to call 911	If the person has any of these symptoms, seek immediate medical attention.	Take note of the time you first noticed the symptoms.

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
